Habitat for Humanity of Edgar County began with a goal of impacting our community and people's lives through elimination of poverty housing and focusing on individual personal development and total living conditions. However, due to the escalating costs of building materials as well as decreases in funding opportunities, the announcement was made by Habitat President Bruce Smith and Habitat for Humanity of Edgar County's board of directors to dissolve operations in Edgar County.

Smith shared that the unanimous desire of the board was that all remaining assets of Habitat should remain in the county to continue Habitat's goals. Faith in Action of Edgar County along with the Edgar County Homeless Organization, are honored to be selected to carry on the mission of Habitat for Humanity of Edgar County. Each organization is dedicated to strengthening our county while providing services that enable our residents to regain and maintain their independence within their communities.

Habitat donated their trailer and all their tools in order to help in our construction of wheelchair ramps and minor home repairs. Cash assets were divided between the two organizations, with Faith in Action receiving a check for the amount of \$5,981.99. These donations are a tremendous blessing and add a great deal of strength to our Special Project program.
